Chong Chun Shiong is currently an associate professor in the Department of Biosciences, Faculty of Science at Universiti Teknologi Malaysia. He joined Universiti Teknologi Malaysia as a tutor in 2006 and was appointed to a University Lectureship in 2007. He completed his PhD in Biology at the University of York, UK in 2011. In 2012, he was promoted as Senior Lecturer at Universiti Teknologi Malaysia. His research of interest is on microbial enzymes for industrial and environmental applications. The current research is focused on identification and characterisation of novel bacteria from environment, and microbial processes of agricultural lignocellulose biomass for generation of value-added products. Chong has supervised 20 Master students, 13 PhD students and mentored 3 postdoctoral researchers. He was awarded with research grants from national and international funding bodies including Fundamental Research Grant, Industry-International Incentive Grant, UK-Malaysia Southeast Asia Newton Fund, UK-Malaysia Newton Fund Impact Scheme and Industrial Grant from China.
